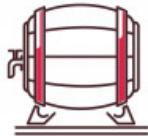

## Tasting notes

This dense, intense wine has a deep purple color. A fine reflection of the vintage, the nose is packed with powerful aromas of blackcurrant and liquorice. Fruity and full-bodied, this Côtes de Blaye boasts a good substance and an enjoyable length of flavour.



## Matching with food

The finish is accented by hints of pepper, making this the ideal partner for a leg of lamb in wild herbs, or a rich goat's cheese.
