Average production - 180 000 bottles

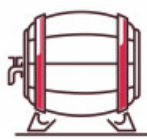
Area of the vineyard - 27 hectares

Ageing – 12 months in vats



Tasting notes

This wine, with a very dark, deep, red color, comes with a nose of black cherry enhanced by minty touches. A wine with an elegant flavour thanks to its strong backbone of ripe tannins.



Matching with food

Its long, pleasant finish make it ideal for drinking with a pepper steak or a sirloin steak cooked over vine shoots. To be tasted between 16° and 18°C
