HISTORY

Located in Villegouge, this vineyard is at the heart of the appellation. With vines averaging 30 years in age, the vineyard is mainly east-west facing. Special care is taken with the vines throughout the year, to produce a wine of excellence that respects the environment and biodiversity. The presence of clay veins in the soil means that the vines are able to regulate their moisture levels and the grapes ripen perfectly.

CULINARY SUGGESTIONS

A fine wine to serve with a salmis of wood pigeon or a leg of duck confit.

TYPE OF SOIL

Silty-clay

VINIFICATION

Vinification in stainless steel and cement tanks

TASTING

Château L'Espérance Bordeaux Supérieur 2013 is a deep red wine with aromas of red fruits and a hint of flowers. On the palate, it is supple and round, with fine tannins and a fresh finish. This wine is pleasant to drink now, but can also be aged for a few years.
